SCHOLARSHIP OFFER

Sanofi Pasteur offers two scholarships for a one year Master degree in Public Health (MPH), focusing on vaccines and vaccination, at Harvard School of Public Health, Boston Massachusetts, U.S. starting on the Fall of 2011 (August/September).

Winners will be entitled to one round trip ticket from the city they currently live to Boston, Massachusetts, U.S.
Housing, meals and transportation costs will also be covered during the length of the scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to qualify for the scholarship selection process candidates must:

- Be fluent in English and Spanish or Portuguese (spoken, written and read)
- Be born and live in a Latin American country where official language is either Spanish or Portuguese
- Plan to return to a Latin American country to work on public health matters
- Have a graduate degree in medicine
- Have worked in the public health field in Latin America for at least two years
- Commitment to be fully dedicated to the post-graduation program

SELECTION CRITERIA

The winners of the scholarship will be chosen based on:

- Academic and professional experience and performance
- Communication skills in Spanish or Portuguese and English
- Desire to direct own career in Latin American public health matters
- Availability to be fully dedicated to the scholarship
- Performance on interviews with the "Beca Sanofi Pasteur" panel which will be composed by Harvard Staff, sanofi pasteur Latin American management and a Public Health expert

There will be two winners chosen by the panel. Sanofi Pasteur will notify winners on December 6th, 2010.

APPLICATION PACKAGE

- Application form
- Updated CV with recent picture
- Photocopies of academic records
- Letter of recommendation by former or current professor
- Personal essay explaining reasons for applying (maximum one page)
- Letter of a public health institution, a university, a research center or a national health institute, ensuring the candidate will get a position once he/she has obtained the Master of Public Health

Applications must be received by December 1st, 2010. Documentation submitted after the closing date will not be considered. The complete application package must be submitted to:
